

North Carolina Equine Liability Law

Warning

Under North Carolina law an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to or death of a participant in equine activities resulting exclusively from the inherent risks of equine activities. Chapter 99E of the North Carolina Statutes.

I HAVE FULLY INFORMED MYSELF OF THE CONTENTS OF THIS LIABILITY RELEASE, EXPRESS ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND RELEASE OF RIGHT TO SUE BY READING IT BEFORE I SIGNED IT ON BEHALF OF MYSELF, MY WARDS, AND MY HEIRS.

This liability Release, Expressed Assumption of Risk and Release of Right to Sue shall be in full force and effect from the date of signing through the calendar year. The participant/guardian must sign a new Liability Release, Expressed Assumption of Risk and Release of Right to Sue at the beginning of each calendar year.
